THE PURPOSE

To connect the communities of Emmer Green and Sonning Common via a safe, non-athletic bike route, a "Greenway", appealing equally to pedestrians and mobility scooter users.

WHAT ABOUT THE B481, PEPPARD ROAD?

It is the shortest route but is problematic. Many people; existing cyclists, and potential bike riders young and old, would be uncomfortable on it. Parents worry about their children using it. Motorists become frustrated when following the slower, more vulnerable pedaller.

Existing surfaced options are longer, less flat, thus unappealing to potential users.

Alternative infrastructure would benefit all parties.

It would bring other social and even economic benefits.
