

Considering Cattle Grids Vs Fenced and Hedged	
Only 4 or 5 required	One mile of fence to install
They are Long lasting	(One mile of hedge to install?)
Their Maintenance is near Zero	Two miles of hedges and trees to maintain
Little of this >>	Greater puncture risk (hawthorns etc.)
Little of this >>	Fallen leaves to remove.
Little of this >>	Fallen branches to remove.
Open aspect + Potential to dodge miscreants.	Some riders may feel confined and thus vulnerable
More available natural light	Relatively less natural light
Dryer = Less moss growth & Less slippery	Tendency to be more damp, more moss, more slippery.
Relatively little land lost from cultivation/grazing	Much more land lost from cultivation/grazing.
Area lost from cultivation can be financially compensated by UK Gov. grants for Wild-Flower Field Margins	No financial compensation? / (Compulsory purchase?)
